Competition Details

Name	National Science Quiz
Eligible Entrants	<p>Entry is open to Australian residents who have registered on https://www.nationalsciencequiz.com.au/ and/or who submit a question via the National Science Quiz website.</p> <p>Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain approval from their parent/guardian before entry. Parental/guardian approval and a valid phone number or email for the parent/guardian must be given on the entry form.</p> <p>Entrants for the Schools Team Prize must be enrolled at an Australian secondary school and have a maximum of eight (8) team members per team. Multiple teams may be submitted from each secondary school.</p> <p>Entrants for a non-secondary schools team and competing in either the Online or Live Audience quiz component prizes up to a maximum of eight (8) team members per team.</p>
Competition Period	<p>The 'Submit a question' component of the competition starts at 12 Noon AEST on Monday 11th July 2023 and ends at 5:00pm 4th August 2023.</p> <p>The live quiz component of the competition starts at 3:30pm AEST on Sunday 27th August 2023 and ends at 5pm AEST on 27th August 2023.</p>
Prize/s	<p>Total prize pool = \$2,150.00 AUD</p> <p>Five (5) prizes will be awarded as follows: 1 x 1000 (1st prize for the winning schools team component), 1 x \$500 (1st prize for the winner of the live quiz component), 1 x \$250 (winner of the online quiz component), and 2 x \$200 visa gift cards (1 each for the best two (2) questions submitted by participants).</p> <p>The gift cards are subject to the standard card terms, which are available at https://onlyonegiftcard.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2022/05/Terms-and-Conditions-OnlyONE-Visa-5.10.22.pdf</p> <p>VISA is not a participant in or sponsor of this promotion.</p> <p>The Secondary Schools Team prize will be issued to the winning registered team's school and not to an individual team member.</p>

<p>Entry Process</p>	<p>To enter the competition, you must, during the Competition Period:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Register via the www.nationalsciencequiz.com.au registration page; and 2. Enter the required registration details including an email address. <p>AND/OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Compose and submit a question to be used in the National Science Quiz via the submit a question form at https://www.nationalsciencequiz.com.au/ <p>Please note: Questions submitted by participants (full or part-thereof) may be used in the quiz itself. If a participant's full submitted question is used in the quiz, the question will be attributed to the author.</p> <p>Entry is limited to one per person or one team (maximum 8 persons) and multiple entries will be deemed invalid.</p>
<p>Selection of Winners</p>	<p>“Submit a question” component:</p> <p>All entries associated with submission of question component of the competition will be judged individually based on their merit. The prize winners will be determined in accordance with the following judging criteria: Quality and suitability of the question for the National Science Quiz, its originality and creativity of the visual components of the video.</p> <p>The winners for the ‘Submit a question’ component will be announced either at the end of the live event on 27th August 2023 or by 5:00pm AEST 3rd September, 2023.</p> <p>Quiz participation component:</p> <p>First prize in the quiz participation component will be awarded as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Online participants – the person or non-secondary team who has the most correct answers in the fastest time. 2. Live participants – the person or non-secondary school team who has the most correct answers in the fastest time. 3. Schools Team participants – the secondary school team who has the most correct answers in the fastest time. <p>The winners of the Live Participants and Schools Teams quiz participation component will be announced at the end of the live event on 27th August 2023. The winners of the Online Participation</p>

	component will be announced on the quiz website www.nationalsciencequiz.com.au on or before 3 rd September, 2023.
Announcement of winners	Each winner will be notified in-person or via email for the online winners within seven (7) business days of the end of the Competition Period using the contact details provided at the time of entry. The name of each winner will be published on the National Science Quiz website https://www.nationalsciencequiz.com.au/ and the event partners social media (Facebook, Instagram, TikTok and Twitter).

1. The promoter of the prize draw is University of Tasmania (ABN 30 764 374 782), specifically the Centre of Excellence for Plant Success of College Road, Sandy Bay, Tasmania, 7005, Australia (**UTAS**).
2. Information on how to enter this competition and prize details published by UTAS form part of these terms and conditions of entry (**Terms**).
3. All entrants agree to the Terms upon submitting their entry. These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Tasmania. If any of these Terms are or become invalid, at our option, the relevant part is severed, and doesn't affect the validity of the remaining parts.
4. Entries must be received during the Competition Period. Entries for 'Submit a question' will be deemed to be accepted at the time of receipt and not at the time of transmission. Incomplete, inaudible or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid. No responsibility will be taken by UTAS for lost, late or misdirected entries.
5. UTAS reserves the right to: a) cancel, terminate, delay, modify or suspend the prize draw at any time; b) withdraw the invitation to participate from any person, including where that person incorrectly receives an invitational email; and c) amend or vary these Terms during the Competition Period.
6. The winner(s) will be chosen as outlined in the above details.
7. Prizes will be provided within 28 days of announcing the winners. They must be taken as offered and visa cards are not redeemable for cash or an alternative prize. Prizes are not transferable.
8. UTAS reserves the right to disqualify any entry or entrants at its discretion at any time if:
 - (a) An entry is submitted not in accordance with these Terms; and/or
 - (b) An entrant engages in unacceptable behaviour, including, but not limited to, behaviour that is hurtful, offensive, discriminatory, obscene, derogatory, sexually explicit or pornographic, defamatory, bullying, trolling, illegal or violent.
9. UTAS's decision on all aspects relating to this competition is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. UTAS may request further information from the prize winner to confirm the prize winner's entry is eligible and complies with these Terms. This may include, for example, requesting proof of identity. This may delay the delivery timeline of the prize as outlined above.

11. By entering, entrants:
 - (a) confirm that any content they submit is original and does not infringe the intellectual property rights or any other rights of third parties;
 - (b) grant UTAS a perpetual, royalty-free, irrevocable, worldwide, non-exclusive licence (with the right to sub-licence) to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, communicate with the public and otherwise exploit the submission content in any media for any purpose (including to advertise or promote any of UTAS's products or services);
 - (c) consent to any act or omission by UTAS that would otherwise infringe any moral rights that may subsist in the entry; and
 - (d) agree to sign any further documentation required by UTAS to give effect to this clause.
12. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure they are readily contactable through the information provided through registration at the time of entry. If incorrect contact information is provided this may delay the delivery timeline of the prize as outlined above.
